The Joshua Foundation is a South Wales based charity which provides holidays and experiences for children with terminal cancer, between the ages of birth and 19 years of age. We provide individual holidays and experiences plus group events such as 'Breakfast with Santa' and Lapland. Since its creation over 5 million pounds have been raised.

The charity takes its name from Joshua Cornelius, from Caerphilly, South Wales who was diagnosed with Desmoplastic Round Cell Tumour of the Abdomen, a terminal cancer. In December 1996 and who died on December 4th 1998, aged 7. After his diagnosis Joshua had to undergo intensive and aggressive chemotherapy. To offset this, in his 23 months of treatment he travelled the world, living life to the full. An experience The Joshua Foundation now endeavours to repeat for others.
